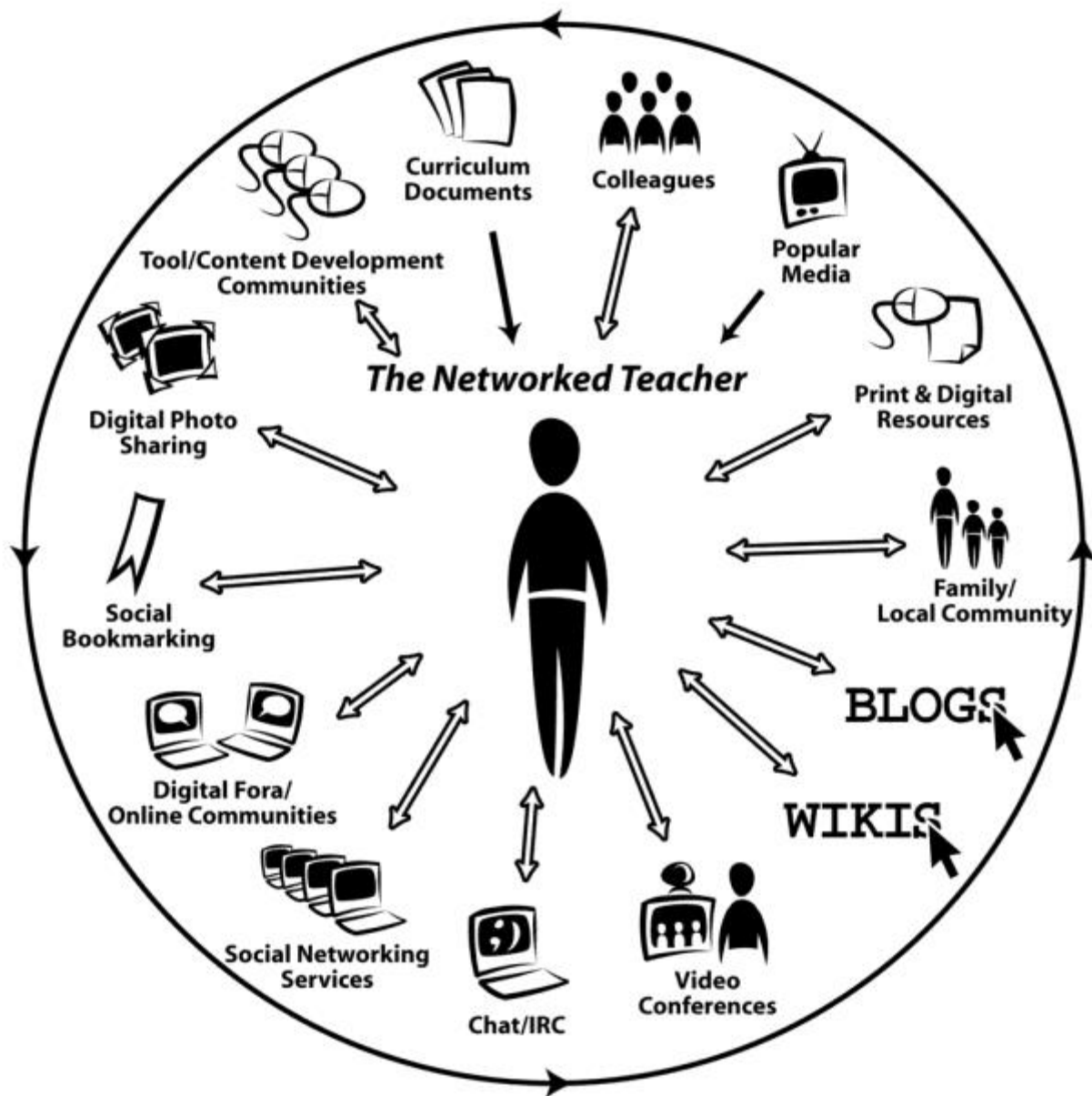




Digital Footprint
